RESULT: Client initially charged with two counts of *Conspiracy to Commit Murder in First Degree* receives reduced charge of one count of *Conspiracy to Bail Jump*, based on evidentiary weaknesses in the State's case that I was able to show. RESULT: Charges of *First Degree Rape* and *Burglary with Sexual Motivation* against my client (a college professor) are dismissed with prejudice after I discovered that emails offered as evidence against him were fabricated by the alleged victim.
